The documents in this attractive and well-printed little volume represent the more important of those papyri (covering the fifth century BC.) discovered at Elephantine or at Assuan between 1898 and 1908a fruitful decade in archaeological discovery and research. Some doubt has here and there been expressed as to their genuineness; for example, the Laudian Professor of Arabic is frankly skeptical. The majority of experts, however, after close and continued scrutiny have accepted these remarkable papyri as genuine records contemporary with the events to which they relate; and the student who reads the first page of Dr. Cowleys interesting introduction will find his imagination kindled as he reads that No. 5 was rolled up, tied and sealed in 471 B.
